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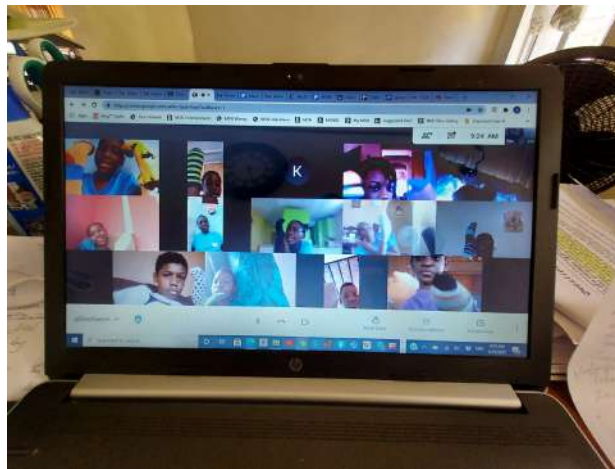
St. Lawrence Rocks Socks- WDSD

LEARNING AT HOME

Practical Tips for Turning Everyday Experiences into Learning Moments

Doing the Laundry

Sorting laundry according to colour
Analysing which pile is bigger or smaller, heavier or lighter
Measuring the amount of detergent needed for the load
Differentiating between wet and dry when picking up the laundry from the line
Estimating how many laundry baskets will be needed to pick up the dry clothing

Word for a Day

Use a word throughout the day and practise spelling the word. The words for the week can be based on a theme like food groups, animals, colours etc

Kitchen Fun

Make something together e.g. lemonade, cookies, pancakes
Take pictures of the process
Retell the steps by putting the pictures in order
Follow a recipe for favourite food or drink
Name and spell the ingredients
Weigh or measure the ingredients to determine the correct amount

Licence Plate Game

Depending on the age, child can:

1. Call the digits e.g. 8375
2. Give the number in words – eight thousand, three hundred and seventy-five
3. Give the place value of any of the digits – e.g. 5 ones
4. Expand the number – $8000+300+70+5$

Find objects that rhyme
Identify colours, etc

I spy something beginning with p
To vary you can also substitute the letter sound /p/
